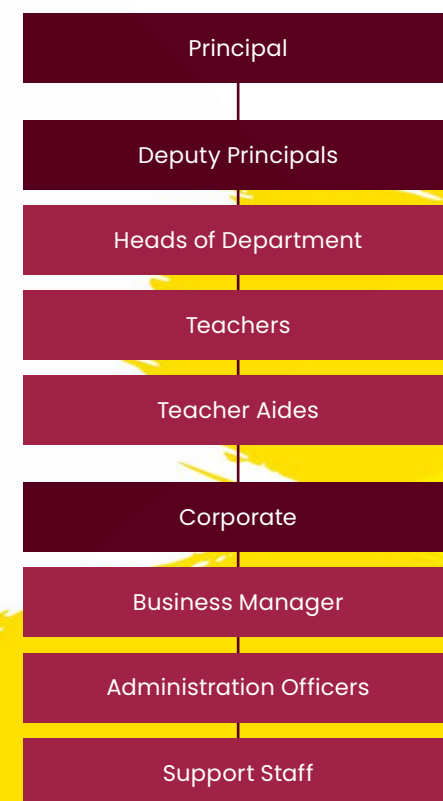

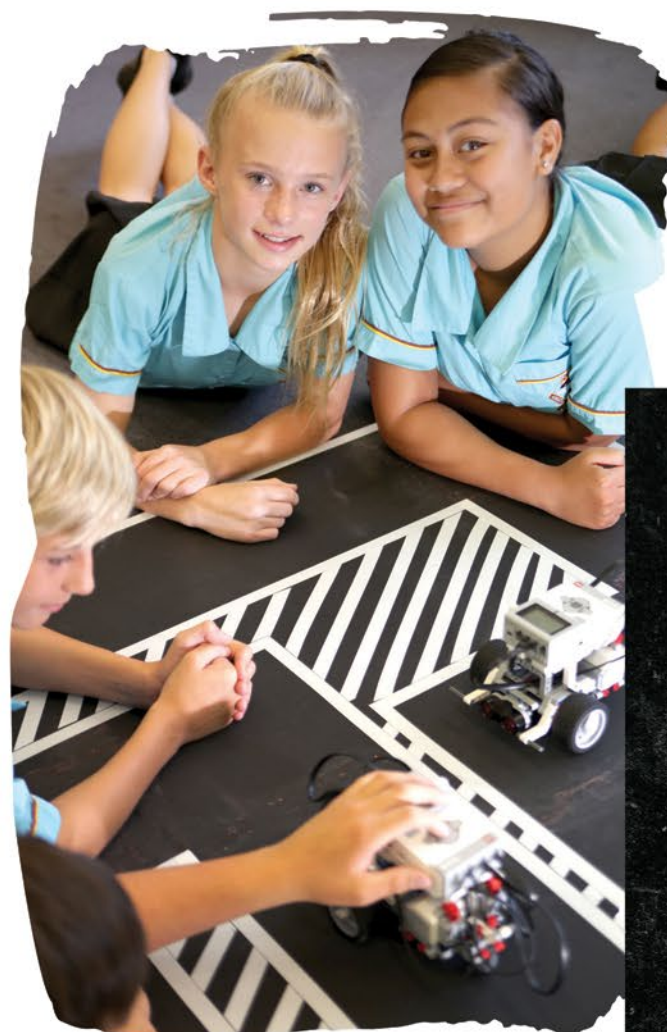


PROGRAMS

Academic Excellence

Supporting and intellectually challenging students to aim higher in their academic learning through the use of Gagne's Four 'DS':

STEM Academy

Keebra Park offers a suite of subjects within the STEM field. Our personalised approach to learning will support students to thrive and succeed from beginning to end. Whether they want to be a chemist, a physicist, an engineer or astronaut, we can tailor the elite academic pathway for them.

Vocational Education

Keebra Park State High School is a Registered Training Organisation delivering nationally recognised training under the Australian Quality Training Framework.

Students may gain a certificate at Keebra Park and the courses also contribute credits towards the Queensland Certificate of Education. Students may also study courses offered by Gold Coast TAFE.



Performing Arts Academy

The enriched arts curriculum includes workshops, excursions and performances. Performing Arts Academy students are also encouraged to participate in extra-curricular activities, such as the musical and Arts Showcase. This extended course also enables students to develop and refine their skills, knowledge and understanding of the Arts.





Gold Coast Titans and NRL Career Wise Program

Our Girls Sport Academy students have the opportunity to work with Gold Coast Titans NRLW stars to plan their career path.

Students work towards setting long term career goals to complement their pursuit of becoming a professional athlete. The program is delivered and supported by the Gold Coast Titans Player Welfare Team.

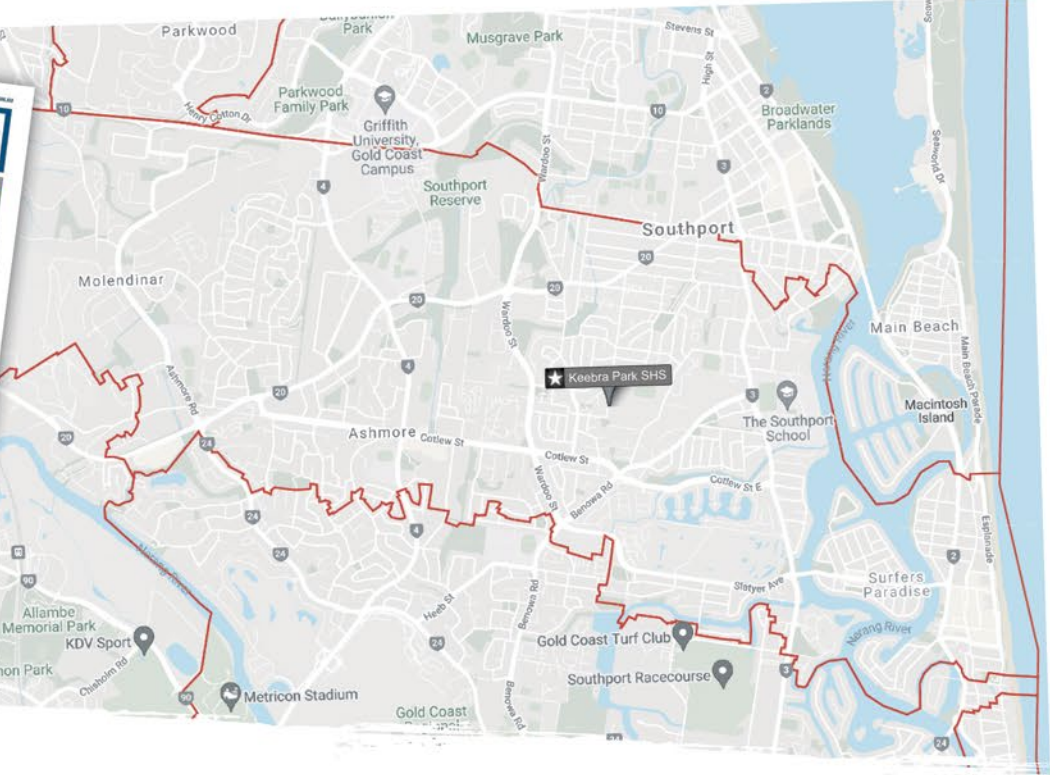

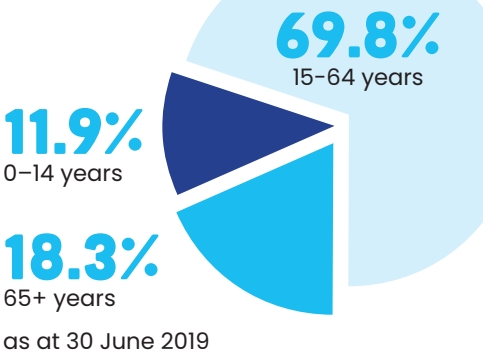

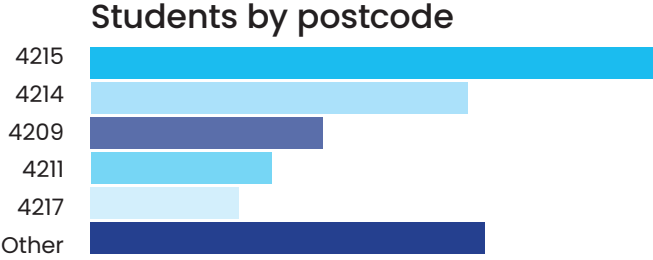
