

Daymap provides a free mobile app for both Android and iPhone users. iPhone users require a minimum of iOS 9.0 and Android users require a minimum of 4.4 (KitKat).

**Please Note:** to access the Daymap Mobile App you require a Daymap Connect licence, external URL set up, parent contacts imported with valid email addresses, Daymap version 10.5 or above and Identity Server.

Once you have downloaded the free app, you will be able to log in to view a range of information, depending on your access.

Staff access includes:

- Push notifications of messages
- Look up students
- Add records
- Mark the roll
- View lesson notes, class posts and assessment tasks
- Calendars and events

Parent access includes:

- Push notifications of messages
- Book Parent-Teacher Interviews
- View all student information: attendance, reports, assessment and results, and student records and notes
- Calendars and events

Student access includes:

- Push Notifications of messages
- Check timetable
- Access class notes, homework and tasks
- View student visible records and notes
- View assessment results and feedback
- Calendars and events

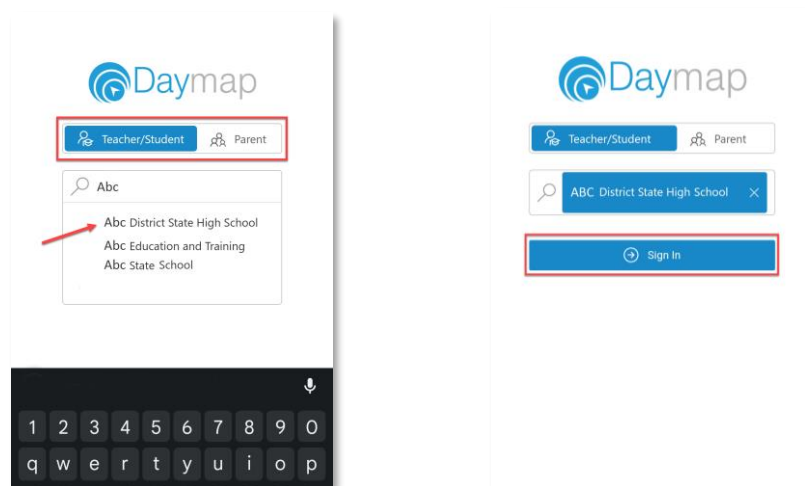

When using **Daymap Mobile** for the first time, you will need to select the user type (selected user type is highlighted in blue) and then type and select your school from the list.



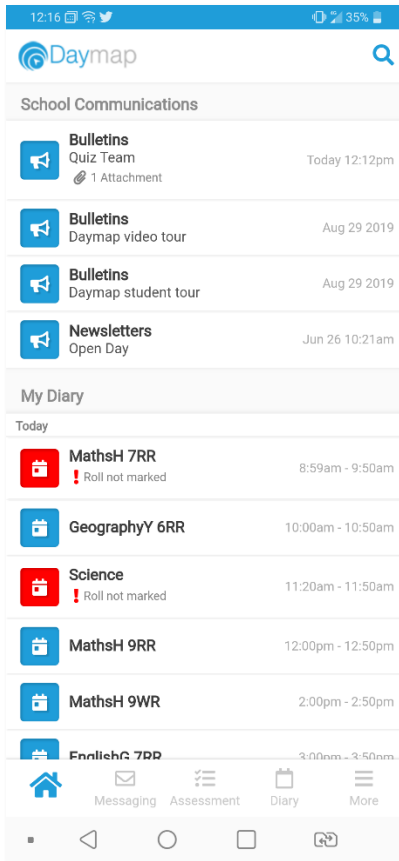
After selecting **Sign In** you will be prompted to enter your personal logon information.

You may be requested to allow Daymap to send you notifications, this will be required if you wish to receive push notifications when you receive a message.

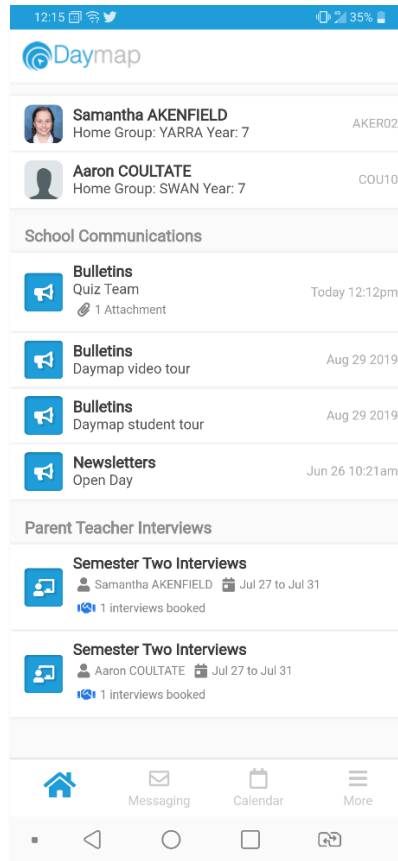
## Daymap Mobile App

Once logged in, your app's home page will look like one of the following:

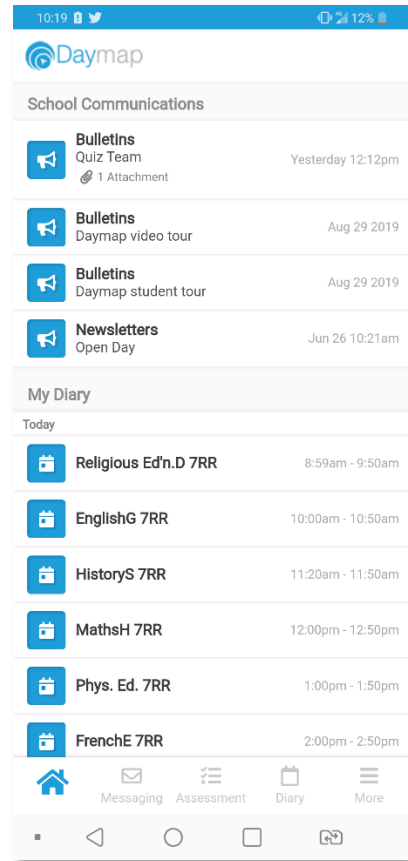
