School-Based Apprenticeships and Traineeships (SATs) at Keebra Park State High School

Keebra Park State High School provides students with hands-on learning opportunities through School-Based Apprenticeships and Traineeships (SATs). These programs allow students to gain paid workplace experience while working towards a nationally recognised qualification—all while completing their Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE).

Why Choose a SAT?

- ✓ Earn While You Learn Students gain real-world skills in a professional environment.
- Career Pathways SATs can lead to full-time employment, TAFE, university, or trade careers.
- ✓ QCE & ATAR Contribution Completion of a SAT contributes towards a Certificate II, III, or higher qualification, counting towards QCE credits and, in some cases, ATAR.
- ✓ Workplace Readiness Develop confidence, industry skills, and a competitive edge in job applications.

Application Process

- 1. Check Current SAT Vacancies with Industry Liaison Officer or on careers boards throughout the school. (Please note, not all traineeship or apprenticeship positions are available through the Industry Liaison Officer and students may also need to find an employer independently.
- 2. Submit an Expression of Interest form to the Industry Liaison Officer.
- 3. Obtain & Complete Application
 - Collect an application form from the Industry Liaison Officer.
 - Create a Unique Student Identifier (USI) at www.usi.gov.au.
 - Prepare a digital copy of your resume.
- 4. Submit the completed application and resume.
 - (For construction-related SATs, a White Card is required before commencing work.)
- 5. Employer Referral & Interview
 - The Industry Liaison Officer forwards your application to the employer or training provider.
 - Students attend an interview and, in most cases, a work trial.
- 6. Final Steps
 - If successful, the student and parent/guardian attend a sign-up session with the employer.
