- Conducting classroom observations and providing feedback on the implementation of active participation explicit instruction strategies.
- Pedagogical coach provide staff with coaching cycles based on AITSL standards.
- Implementing "Write that Essay" targeting writing intervention across the whole school
- Increasing the use of restorative practices and re-engagement programs.
- Utilise the 5 questions at all levels within the school to provide feedback on the next steps to learning.
- Develop a student leadership framework and a pathway for student leaders.
