# UNIFORM POLICY

#### **School Uniform Policy**

At Keebra Park SHS our school uniform provides students with a sense of belonging and the appearance of our students enhances our public image and reputation within our community.

Behaviour or conduct that brings the school into disrepute whilst wearing our school uniform, or parts thereof, will be actioned under the school's Student Code of Conduct.

The uniform has been designed in consultation with the staff, students, parents/carers, and wider school community.

#### Student Dress Code

#### **Expectations of Keebra Park SHS students**

Students are encouraged to take pride in their appearance and to keep their uniform clean, neat and tidy. The uniform is to be worn at all times at school and when travelling to and from school.

- All uniforms are to be purchased from the school uniform shop (excluding socks and shoes)
- Uniforms may not be altered in any fashion. This includes, but not limited to:
  - cutting or shortening hemlines
  - Rolling up of sleeves or shorts
  - Rolling down of shirt tops
  - Re- embroidering, replicating or reproducing the school logo of badges.
- Visible undergarments are not permitted to be worn.

#### **Uniform Routines**

Keebra Park State High School students are required to wear their formal or sports/academy uniform every lesson, every day. Training singlets are only permitted when participating in organised sports training.

Complete formal uniform is to be worn on all excursions and at formal occasions unless otherwise stipulated (Academy students see table below for game day uniform expectations).

Failure to observe the Student Dress Code may result in the following consequences:

- Request to remove the item/s
- Request to change the item/s from a pool of clothing in the Uniform Shop
- Parental contact to provide alternate attire or, in the case of repetitive inappropriate dress, negotiation with parents and students may be held.
- Supervised learning provided out of the classroom for the period that the inappropriate attire is worn.
- Lunch-time detention









#### Uniform

#### Junior Formal Uniform (Year 7 – 9)

- o Shirt Keebra Park aqua button up shirt
- o Skirt Keebra Park black pleated knee-length skirt or
- o Shorts Keebra Park black dress shorts
- o Long Pants Black tailored dress pants
- o Socks Short white visible socks or Keebra Park white socks
- o Shoes All black, fully enclosed shoes with black laces
- o Jacket Keebra Park maroon or black jacket
- o Hat Keebra Park cap or bucket hat
- o Belt Black

#### Senior Formal Uniform (Year 10-12)

- o Shirt Keebra Park white blouse/ button down shirt worn with the school tie
- o Skirt Keebra Park black pleated knee-length skirt or
- o Shorts- Keebra Park black dress shorts
- o Long Pants Black tailored dress pants
- o Socks Short white visible socks or Keebra Park white socks
- o Shoes All black, fully enclosed shoes with black laces
- o Jacket Keebra Park school maroon or black jacket
- o Hat Keebra Park cap or bucket hat
- o **Belt** Black
- o **Tie** Compulsory when representing the school / formal occasions

#### Sports Uniform All Year Levels

- o Shirt Keebra Park aqua sports polo or Sporting Academy training shirt (not singlet)
- o **Shorts** –Keebra Park maroon sport shorts or Sporting Academy shorts.
- o Long pants maroon track-suit pants (not to be worn with formal uniform)
- o Socks Short white visible socks or Keebra Park white socks
- o Shoes All black, fully enclosed shoes with black laces
- o Jacket Keebra Park school maroon or black jacket
- o Hat Keebra Park cap or bucket hat

#### Unacceptable Items

- Beanies, bandannas, headbands
- Hoodies (including South Coast School Sport and older style Keebra Park SHS)
- Neck Scarves.

#### Headwear

- Keebra Park SHS cap or bucket hat are to be worn. Non-school hats are not acceptable
- A hat should be worn while outdoors. It is inappropriate for hats to be worn indoors.
- Hats are not to be worn backwards.









• Under their belief system, students who choose to wear head dress must wear one of the school colours: maroon, black, white or blue

#### Footwear

Due to Workplace Health and Safety regulations, students' footwear must provide adequate protection and cover the entire foot. Students must wear:



- All black, fully enclosed shoes with black laces
- Any sport specific shoe required for classes (eg. football boots) can only be worn during that lesson/training session.
- Plain white socks (approx. 5-10cm in length above ankle) or Keebra Park white socks.





#### Unacceptable items:

- High top boots
- Shoes with coloured trims or coloured logos
- Shoes with white or coloured laces
- Slip on shoes / slides / crocs

#### Jewellery

- Must be restricted to one wrist watch and a maximum of two sets of small earrings in each ear.
- One small nose stud permitted (no rings).
- Earrings must be no larger than 5mm in diameter and may be a gold or silver sleeper, or a small silver, gold, pearl or diamond stud only.
- Large costume earrings, hoops, dangle or droplet earrings, spacers, stretchers and spikes are not permitted.
- Other visible body piercing is not permitted.
- Religious or cultural items may be worn on a long chain under formal or polo shirt but must NOT be visible.

#### Make-up

• Students are allowed minimal natural appearance make-up and natural coloured nail polish.

#### Additional Approved Items

- Girls may wear black stockings under their formal skirts. Leggings are not acceptable
- Students with genuine religious, cultural or medical considerations may discuss their particular concerns with the Principal or his delegate. Where exemptions to the uniform policy are granted for such reason the student must carry a note signed by the principal at all times.

#### Out of Uniform

A note from parent/carer must be provided via Student Services to explain and excuse the unavoidable occasions when correct uniform is not able to be worn. Incorrect jumpers will not be tolerated and must be removed. Ongoing non-compliance will result in student being asked to hand item into Student Services.
